Once in a while, when there is a critical mass of newcomers attending our worship services, Rev. Jolie offers a class called "New to UU / New to UCS." We cover such topics as Unitarian and Universalist history, what UU's believe, and why Coffee Hour is so darn crucial to our community's wellbeing. At this class, we also talk about what it means to become members of UCS. It might seem like church life is basically unchanged by membership. After all, anyone is welcome to attend worship and participate in most of our events, regardless of if they have officially joined. Of course, becoming a member does confer certain privileges, such as the right to vote in our congregational meetings and eligibility to serve on our Board of Trustees. But membership is about more than voting and serving on the Board. It's about saying to ourselves and each other: this is my place and these are my people. And it's about saying: I want to be part of what it takes to help this community thrive.

By doing this, we keep our promise to be faithful stewards of this house of worship. We keep giving so that we may keep growing, together.

FAIR-SHARE CONTRIBUTING

How much should you pledge? Your contribution reflects both your commitment and your resources. The UUA notes that commitment and provides a guide to giving at a percent of income. They suggest adding all sources of income, then subtracting any large or unusual expenses, like medical or college tuition, to arrive at an adjusted annual income.

Supporter: Our congregation is a significant part of your spiritual life that you want to support. Commitment at this level is between 2% and 6% of adjusted annual income.

Sustainer: The congregation is your central community and you are committed to supporting its programs and ministry. Your contribution will be between 3% and 7% of adjusted income.

Visionary: Your commitment demonstrates the unique importance of the congregation and your spiritual principles. Giving at this level is between 5% and 9% of adjusted income.

Transformer: You are deeply committed to this congregation and want to provide fuel for transformation. Your commitment represents 10% of your adjusted income.
